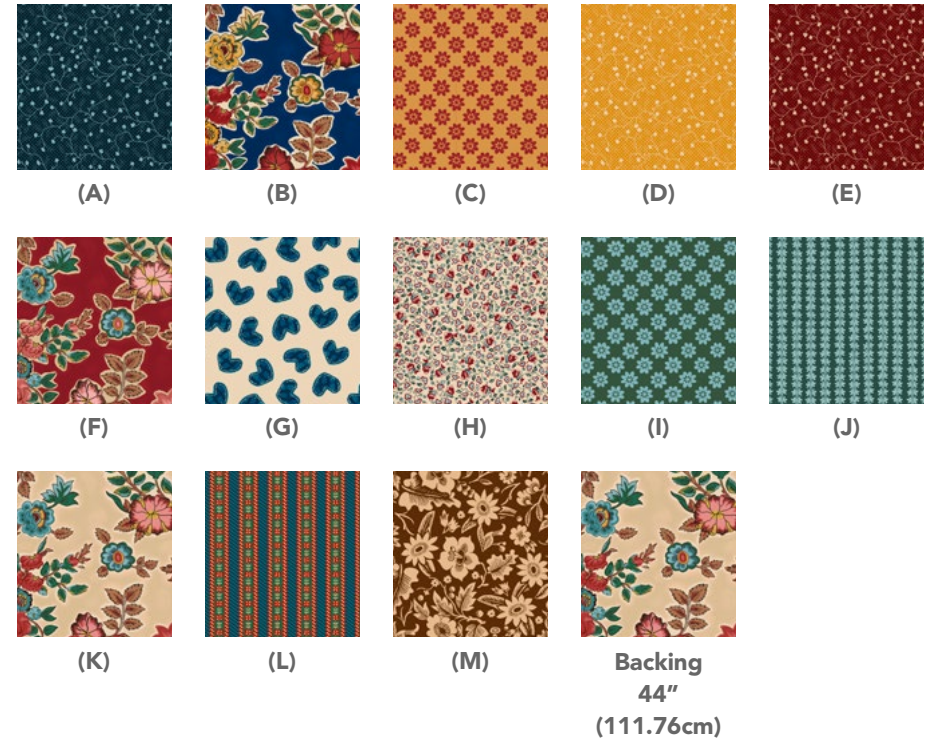

## Additional Requirements

- Coats Dual Duty XP® All-Purpose thread
- 68" x 78" (172.72cm x 198.12cm) batting
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter/mat/ruler
- Basic sewing and pressing supplies

## Cutting Instructions

**WOF = Width of Fabric**

### Fabric A, cut:

(4) 5½" x WOF (13.97cm x WOF);  
sub-cut (4) 5½" x 30½" (13.97cm x 77.47cm)

### Fabrics B and C, cut from each:

(4) 5½" x WOF (13.97cm x WOF);  
sub-cut (4) 5½" x 25½" (13.97cm x 64.77cm)

### Fabrics D and E, cut from each:

(2) 5½" x WOF (13.97cm x WOF);  
sub-cut (4) 5½" x 20½" (13.97cm x 52.07cm)

### Fabrics F and G, cut from each:

(2) 5½" x WOF (13.97cm x WOF);  
sub-cut (4) 5½" x 15½" (13.97cm x 39.37cm)

### Fabrics H and I, cut from each:

(1) 5½" x WOF (13.97cm x WOF);  
sub-cut (4) 5½" x 10½" (13.97cm x 26.67cm)

### Fabric J, cut:

(1) 5½" x WOF (13.97cm x WOF);  
sub-cut (4) 5½" (13.97cm) squares

### Fabric K, cut:

(1) 5½" x WOF (13.97cm x WOF);  
sub-cut (4) 5½" (13.97cm) squares

### Fabric L, cut:

(3) 6½" x WOF (16.51cm x WOF);  
cut (2) 6½" x 40½" (16.51cm x 102.87cm),  
(2) 6½" x 20½" (16.51cm x 52.07cm)

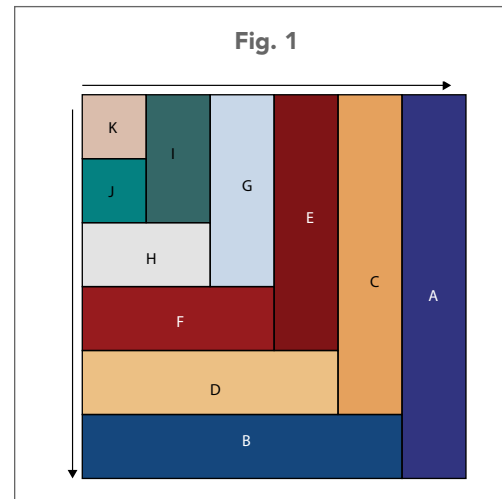
### Fabric M, cut:

(7) 2¼" x WOF (5.71cm x WOF), for binding

## Sewing

**Note:** All seams allowances are ¼" (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press all seams as indicated by arrows in the diagrams.

1. Sew the 5½" (13.97cm) **Fabrics A-K** pieces together, starting with the 5½" (13.97cm) **Fabric K** squares to make (4) blocks as shown (**Fig. 1**).



2. Sew a 6½" x 20½" (16.51cm x 52.07cm) **Fabric L** to the end of a 6½" x 40½" (16.51cm x 102.87cm), to make (2) top/bottom borders.

## Quilt Top Assembly

3. Noting the orientation, sew the blocks together as shown in the **Quilt Layout** on page 4 to make the quilt top.
4. Sew (1) border to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt top, matching ends and centers.

## Finishing

5. Sew together the (7) 2¼" x WOF (5.72cm x WOF) **Fabric M** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
6. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
7. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
8. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
