

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INTERSTELLAR QUILT PATTERN

Materials and Cutting		
Fabric	Yardage	Cutting*
 Spaceships Stella-1278 Midnight	1 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 3 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 36 C squares, 3 1/2" x 3 1/2". 3 strips, 7 1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 14 B squares, 7 1/4" x 7 1/4".
 Lost in Space Stella-1277 Midnight	7/8 yard	Cut: 1 strip, 9 3/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 2 squares, 9 3/8" x 9 3/8". Cut each square once diagonally to make 4 corner triangles . 1 strip, 18 1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 2 squares, 18 1/4" x 18 1/4". Cut each square twice diagonally to make 8 setting triangles .
 Space Magic Stella-1276 Midnight	3/4 yard	Cut: 2 strips, 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut 16 C squares, 3 1/2" x 3 1/2". 2 strips, 7 1/4" x WOF. Sub-cut 6 B squares, 7 1/4" x 7 1/4".
 Lightning Stella-1280 Midnight	1/2 yard	Cut: 7 strips, 2 1/4" x WOF, for binding.
 Moonscape Stella-1150 Lemon	3/8 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 3 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 24 A squares, 3 7/8" x 3 7/8".
 Unicorns in Space Stella-1279 Bubblegum	3/8 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 3 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 24 A squares, 3 7/8" x 3 7/8".
 Unicorns in Space Stella-1279 Aquarius	3/8 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 3 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 24 A squares, 3 7/8" x 3 7/8".
 Moonscape Stella-1150 Cockatoo	1/8 yard	Cut: 1 strip, 3 7/8" x width of fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 6 A squares, 3 7/8" x 3 7/8".
 Moonscape Stella-1150 Aquarius	2 1/2 yards	Cut: 1 strip, 30" x WOF strip. Sub-cut 2 rectangles, 30" x 20". Reserve the rectangles and remaining yardage for the backing.
Other		
Batting	60" x 60"	

Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise instructed.


Make the Blocks

1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **A** square.



2 Referring to the quilt photo for fabric combinations, select 4 matching **A** squares and one 1 **B** square. With right sides together, place two of the **A** squares in opposite corners of the **B** square, matching outer edges. The inner corners of the **A** squares will

overlap about 1/4", and the diagonal lines drawn on the squares should align. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the lines. Cut the along the drawn lines. Press the smaller triangles away from the larger triangle.




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INTERSTELLAR QUILT PATTERN


3 Place one of the remaining **A** squares right side down on the corner of each of the step 1 units as shown. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line. Press the smaller triangles away from the larger triangles to make four Flying Geese units. If necessary, trim each unit to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

4 Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make Flying Geese units in the following number and fabric combinations:




5 Arrange 6 matching Flying Geese units and four matching **C** squares in three rows as shown. Join the units and squares in each row together. Press. Join the rows together,


matching seamlines. Press. Trim and square each block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make a total of 13 blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

1 Referring to the **Quilt Assembly Diagram** for block placement and

orientation, arrange the blocks and setting triangles in five diagonal rows. Sew the blocks and triangles in each diagonal row together along adjacent edges. Press.

2 Sew the rows together along adjacent edges, matching seamlines. Press the seam allowances in one direction.

3 Sew the long edge of one corner triangle to each corner of the quilt top. Press.

Finishing

1 Remove the selvages from the backing yardage and rectangles. Join the rectangles together along one short end, using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Press. Sew the joined rectangles to one long edge of the remaining yardage. Press.

2 Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.



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
