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## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric
Note: If desired, press fabrics with starch or starch alternative and let dry before cutting to stabilize edges to that will be cut or trimmed on the bias. Handle bias-cut pieces carefully so as not to distort.

From Fabrics A, B, C, and D, cut from each:
(1) $5 \frac{1}{8}$ " $\times$ WOF; cut
(1) $51 / 8^{" ~} \times 51 / 8$ ", then cut diagonally once to yield (2) half-square triangles. Trim the remainder of the strip to $5^{\prime \prime}$ and cut
(1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$, (4) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
(2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; cut
(2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$
(3) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2 "$

From Fabrics E, F, G, and H, cut from each:
(3) $5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; cut
(4) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2 "$
(3) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$

From Fabrics I, K, M, and O, cut from each: (3) 2" x WOF; cut
(3) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$
(3) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 91^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ "

## From Fabrics J, L, and N, cut from each:

Enough $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ - wide bias strips to make 400" ( 10.16 m ) of bias binding

From Fabrics $\mathbf{Q}$, S, U, and W, cut from each: (3) 2 " $\times$ WOF; cut
(3) 2 " $\times 11^{\prime \prime}$
(3) 2 " $\times 91_{1}^{\prime \prime}$
(2) 2 " $\times 4 \frac{1}{4}$ "
(4) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$
(10) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$

From Fabrics $R, T, V$, and $X$, cut from each:
(3) 2 " $\times$ WOF; cut
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(3) 2 " $\times 3 \frac{112 " 1}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$
(11) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$

From Fabrics Y, AA, AC, and AE, cut from each:
(3) 2" x WOF; cut
(3) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$
(3) 2 " $\times 9 \frac{1}{2}$ "
(2) 2 " $\times 5^{11 / 2 "}$
(16) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$

From Fabrics $Z, A B, A D$, and $A F$, cut from each:
(4) 2 " $\times$ WOF; cut
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$
(4) 2 " $\times 91 / 2 "$
(19) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ "

From Fabrics AG, AH, AI, AJ, AK, AL, AM, and AN, cut from each:
(2) $75 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; cut
(7) $75 / 8$ " $\times 75 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, then cut diagonally twice to yield (28) quarter-square triangles

## Instructions

Note: Read the instructions all the way through before beginning. All seam allowances are $1 / 4{ }^{\prime \prime}(0.64 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pieces are sewn right sides together. Press all seams as indicated by the arrows in the diagrams. For all steps, sew the units/blocks together using the cut pieces from the same colorway: Aura, Cosmic, Karma, Lunar, Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit. Use the table below for quick reference.

## Block Construction

1. Sew together the 2 " $\times 2$ " Fairy Flakes and Pom Pom, 2 " $\times 3 \frac{112}{2}$ Pom Pom and Tent Stripe, and 2" $\times 5$ " Tent Stripe pieces as shown in Figure 1 to make a Quarter Log Cabin Unit. Make (4) Units each of Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit. Make (3) Units and of Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma.

Make 4 each: Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, Spirit Make 3 each: Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, Karma
2. Sew a matching colorway pair of $75 / 8$ " Fairy Dust triangles to the top of each Quarter Log Cabin Unit as shown to make A Units.

Make 4 each: Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, Spirit Make 3 each: Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, Karma
3. Sew matching $5^{\prime \prime} \times 9 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ and $5^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ feature print rectangles to the bottom of all the $A$ Units to make B Units.

Make 4 each: Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, Spirit Make 3 each: Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, Karma

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4. Set aside (2) each Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit B Units. Then sew a matching pair of 75/8" Fairy Dust triangles to the top of the remaining (2) Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit, and all the Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma B Units as shown to complete the Triangle A Blocks.

Make 2 each: Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, Spirit Make 3 each: Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, Karma
5. Sew the 2 " $\times 23 / 4$ " Tent Stripe, $2 " \times 41 / 4 "$ Pom Pom, and 2 " $\times 51 / 2$ " Fairy Flakes pieces together as shown, then add to matching 75/8" Fairy Dust triangles as shown to make the Left and Right End A Units. Make (1) each of Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit (8 total).

6. Sew a single matching 75/8" Fairy Dust triangle to the top and an End Unit to the bottom of the Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit B Units as shown to make (1) Left End Triangle A and (1) Right End Triangle A. Note: Align and pin to match the seams between the Left End A Unit and the B Unit.

7. Sew a pair of matching $75 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fairy Dust triangles to the bottom of a matching 5" x 5" feature print square to make a C Unit. If needed, trim $1 / 4$ " from the bottom point of the square, making sure that the straight edge is at a $45^{\circ}$ angle from both seams. Make (3) each Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit. Make (4) each Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma.

8. Sew a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fairy Flakes square to one end of each 2" $\times 9 \frac{112}{2}$ and $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Pom Pom piece to make the $D$ and $E$ Units. Make (3) each of Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit. Make (4) each of Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma.

Sew a 2" x 2" Pom Pom square to one end of each $2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{1 / 2 "}$ "and $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Tent Stripe piece. Then sew a $2 " \times 2$ " Fairy Flakes square to the same end of each to make the F Units and G Units. Make (3) each of Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit. Make (4) each of Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma.

9. To all the C Units, add $2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ and $2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ Fairy Flakes pieces and the $D, E, F$, and $G$ Units as shown to complete a total of (7) H Units.


Make 3 each: Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, Spirit Make 4 each: Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, Karma

## High Voltage Quilt

10. Set aside (2) H Units each of Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma. Sew a $75 / 8$ " Fairy Dust triangle to the bottom of each remaining H Unit to make the Triangle B Blocks. Make (3) Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, Spirit, and (2) Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma.

Make 3 each: Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, Spirit Make 2 each: Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, Karma
11. Sew a matching 77/8" Fairy Dust triangle and $51 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ feature print triangle together as shown along the short sides, aligning the square corners, to make End B Units. Make (1) each of Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma ( 8 total).
Note: the triangles will be practically the same size but are cut from different sized squares for more efficient use of the feature print fabric.

12. Sew a single matching 75/8" Fairy Dust triangle to the bottom and an End B Unit to the top of the remaining Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma H Units as shown to make (1) Left End Triangle B and (1) Right End Triangle B (8 total).

## Quilt Top Assembly

13. Arrange a matching Left End Triangle A, (3) Triangle B Blocks, (2) Triangle A Blocks, rotated as shown, and a Right End Triangle A as shown to make a row. Sew together, aligning seams as in step 6, to make a Row A. Make (1) Row A each of Moon Beam, Mystic, Nova, and Spirit. Do not square off the ends of the rows yet.

14. Arrange a matching Left End Triangle B, (3) Triangle A Blocks, (2) Triangle B Blocks, and a Right End Triangle B as shown to make a row. Sew together, aligning seams as in step 6, to make a Row B. Make (1) Row B each of Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, and Karma.
Do not square off the ends of the rows yet.

Make 1 each Row B: Aura, Cosmic, Lunar, Karma
15. Starting with all of Row B, draw a vertical line at each end of each Row $B$, aligned with the raw edge of the feature print triangles. The rows should measure approximately 901/4" long, including seam allowance ( $893 / 4$ " finished). Then measure all the Row A's from the center out to the same length $\left(451 / 8^{\prime \prime}\right.$ from the center, or half of the length of your Row B's) and mark.

Staystitch $1 / 16^{\prime \prime}$ (or a needle width) to the inside of the marked lines. Trim the ends to square up the rows, cutting $1 / 16^{\prime \prime}$ to the outside of the drawn line to preserve the staystitching.
Note: The staystitching will prevent the bias ends of each row from stretching. For best results, use an even-feed/walking foot to staystitch.
16. Refer to the Quilt Layout diagram (page 10) to sew the Rows $A$ and B together from top to bottom in the following order: Nova, Lunar, Moon Beam, Karma, Spirit, Aura, Mystic, Cosmic.

## Finishing

17. Sew together the $2^{11 / 2 "}$ Fabric $P$ binding strips end-to-end. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
18. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
19. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4$ " and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
20. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
